The Documents Required for Tibet Travel

Tibet Autonomous Region is not a fully open destination. Non-Chinese nationals are required valid passport, Chinese visa and the Aliens' Travel Permit to travel in Tibet. To obtain this Alien's Travel Permit issued by Tibet Tourism Bureau, tourists must have licensed Tibetan agencies to organize their tours, and must be accompanied by guide throughout. Non-Chinese nationals and Taiwan Chinese are prohibited to travel independently in Tibet. Foreign diplomats and journalists are prohibited to enter Tibet as tourists.

The following documents are required to apply for the Alien's Travel Permit.

For non-Chinese nationals holding **L visa**, required documents include:

- 1) **copy of passport main page**
- 2) **copy of valid Chinese visa**
- 3) **occupation information**

For non-Chinese nationals holding Z visa, required documents include:

- 1) copy of passport main page
- 2) copy of valid Chinese visa
- 3) copy of the Alien Employment Permit

For non-Chinese nationals holding F visa, required documents include:

- 1) copy of passport main page
- 2) copy of valid Chinese visa
- 3) Justification Letter from the units responsible for the applicants' stay in China

It's advised to submit the above documents, together with confirmed tour dates and itinerary, at least **two weeks in advance**.
